TAX LEVY

Real Estate Tax at the rate of One-Hundred Fifty-Four and Six Tenths (154.6) Mills, or \$15.46 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of taxable real property, in the Townships of East Bradford, East Goshen, Thornbury, West Goshen, Westtown, and West Whiteland, and the Borough of West Chester, all of Chester County, Pennsylvania, and Four Hundred Seven and One Tenth (407.1) Mills, or \$40.71 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of taxable real property, in the Township of Thornbury, Delaware County, Pennsylvania.

Legally, school district real estate taxes must be equalized between counties based on the most recent market value certified by the State Tax Equalization Board (STEB). For 1996-97, Delaware County represented 4.33% of the total market value of the School District; for 1997-98, Delaware County represents 4.53%.
